PLEASE READ THE INFORMATION BELOW AND SIGN

HOUSING DEPOSITS: An application for housing cannot be processed unless accompanied by a check or money order for \$100.00 (U.S.) made payable to the University of Central Arkansas. The housing deposit can also be paid online at www.uca.edu/housing. If you choose to pay your housing deposit online, we must receive your housing application within seven days of your online payment. If we do not receive your housing application within seven days of your deposit payment, your deposit will be returned to you. The \$100 deposit is refundable if the student gives written notice of cancellation to our office no later than May 10. Students cancelling from May 11 – July 10 are entitled to a \$50.00 refund. Cancellation after these dates will result in forfeiture of the housing deposit. **New Spring 2010 applicants** canceling from December 2 until January 1 are entitled to a \$50.00 refund. Cancellation after these dates will result in the forfeiture of the housing deposit.

HOUSING LEASE: The housing lease is for the entire academic year. A housing lease is a separate document and is not the same as a housing application. The housing lease must be signed and returned to the Housing Office. **Failure to sign and submit a housing lease may result in a cancellation of your housing assignment.** Students who fail to terminate their housing lease in writing prior to August 10 (January 2 for Spring semester applicants) will be held responsible for the remainder of the lease charges and will incur a lease buy-out fee as approved by the Board of Trustees.

MEAL PLANS/DECLINING CASH BALANCE (DCB): Meal plans are non-transferable. The DCB (declining cash balance) is **NON-REFUNDABLE**.

ROOMMATE PREFERENCE: Students wishing to room together **MUST** request each other. Roommate requests received after April 1 cannot be guaranteed.

ROOM ASSIGNMENTS: Assignments are made without regard to race, creed or national origin. The University of Central Arkansas is an affirmative action/equal opportunity institution.
