



Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) LPN-to-BSN Curriculum Plan
No Summer Enrollment Required

This curriculum plan is designed for License Practical Nurses (LPNs) who wish to become Registered Nurses (RNs) with a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree. Qualified LPNs or LPTNs receive up to 13 hours of BSN nursing credit based on previous education. Students must complete the required pre-requisite courses prior to being admitted to the nursing major. All courses with asterisks (*) must be completed with a minimum grade of "C" and are required for the nursing major. The 2nd number in each course represents the number of credit hours. If a program requirement can be met by more than one course, those options are listed and separated by "or." Students are responsible for meeting prerequisites for all courses. This is a sample curriculum plan and is for information only.
