



ADULT NURSE PRACTITIONER PLAN OF STUDY

This curriculum plan is designed for Registered Nurses (RNs) who are graduates of an accredited Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program and are seeking the Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) degree specializing as a Nurse Practitioner in the area of Adult health. This track is designed for the working RN with all nursing courses offered online. Periodic visits to the Conway campus are required for each course. The 2nd number in each course represents the number of credit hours. All nursing courses use the prefix "NURS"; it is abbreviated in this document to add space. This is a sample curriculum plan and is for information only.
