QUICK CLICKS

CFDA

CFDA=Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance

- Go to <http://www.cfda.gov/>
- In right-hand column type in Key Word or Program Number and select search

Federal Register

- Go to <http://www.gpoaccess.gov/fr/index.html>
- Under Database Features select Browse
- Choose current issue or back issues of the FR
- Scroll through applicable agencies (Key term to look for under Notices is Request for Proposals)
- For programs that interest you, then select TEXT or PDF format for that program

Grants.gov

- Go to <http://www.grants.gov/>
- Select Find Grant Opportunities
- Select either Basic Search (keyword, funding op # or CFDA #), Browse by Category, Browse by Agency, or Advanced Search

*NOTE: On right side, there are various options for Blogs, E-mail alerts, etc.

NIH

NIH=National Institutes of Health

- Go to <http://www.nih.gov/>
- You can do a quick search by typing in your Keyword or Funding Opportunity Number in the Search Funding Opportunities box and selecting search, OR
- Under the Grants column at the bottom of the page, select Grants & Funding
- Under Funding Opportunities, Search Funding Opportunities: NIH Guide for Grants and Contracts, type a Keyword in box and select Go. You may also search by selecting the Funding Opportunities (FRAs, PAs) & Notices link or the Unsolicited Applications (Parent Announcements) link.

US ED

US ED=United States Department of Education

- Go to <http://www.ed.gov/>
- In the last column under Information Centers, select Grants & Contracts
- Under Grants, click on the drop-down box and select either "What competitions are open now?" OR "Grant Opportunities."

NSF

NSF=National Science Foundation

- Go to <http://www.nsf.gov/>
- Select Find Funding Opportunities in the left hand column
- You can conduct your search by utilizing the A-Z index, or type in the full-text title or keyword in the box, or select Advanced Funding Search, or Browse by Program Areas. The Upcoming Due Dates link in the left hand column is also a quick way to find programs and due dates.

Research.gov

Research.gov is a partnership of federal research-oriented grant making agencies led by NSF.
