____ (1) 2.5 cumulative GPA on all coursework attempted; transfer and Post BAC students must have a cumulative 2.5 GPA on all course work attempted and must also establish a 2.5 GPA on a minimum of 12 semester hours at UCA; (2) Praxis I passing scores; (3) EDUC 1240 Educational Technology Skills or Technology Competency exam; (4) two undergraduate writing classes, oral communication, a math class equivalent to Math 1360 or above with grades of C or better; (5) two faculty recommendations; (6) admission interview with history department faculty.

Application for Program Admission including faculty interview must be completed by OCT 1 for Fall or MARCH 1 for Spring.
