

FLOWCHART FOR MINORS IN CHINESE REVISED (8/1/2009)

A minor in Chinese (Mandarin) requires a minimum of 18 hours of courses at the 2310 level or above.

These 18 hours must include:

Chinese 2310, 2320, 3300 and 3303;

Chinese 3312: Chinese Culture and Society

Chinese 3320: Advanced Reading in Chinese;

Satisfactory performance on proficiency tests upon entrance to and exit from the minor program.

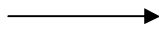
A minimum grade of C in each course applying to the minor/major program.

Summer or a semester of study in a Chinese-speaking country is strongly encouraged.

THE FOLLOWING COURSES ARE REQUIRED OF ALL MINORS

• The first **two courses** (6 credits) **MUST BE TAKEN IN SEQUENCE**, one semester at a time for students who begin study at UCA in Chinese 2310 or lower:

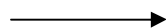
1) Chinese 2310
Intermediate Chinese I



2) Chinese 2320
Intermediate Chinese II

As soon as possible after completing 2320 students should take

3) Chinese 3300 (Adv. Grammar I)



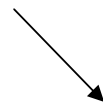
4) Chinese 3303 (Adv. Grammar II)

Chinese minors may take any upper division Chinese course after completing 3300, but must take BOTH courses below (6 credits total):



CIVILIZATION

OR



LITERATURE/READING

• **Chinese 3312** (Chinese Civilization)

• **Chinese 3320** (Adv. Reading)

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Chinese 1410, 1420, and 2340 may not be used as credit toward completion of the minor.
- World Language classes (WLAN 1300, 2315, 2325, 2350, 4315, 4325, 4330) do NOT count towards the minor in Chinese.
- In order to graduate, every UCA student must have a total of **124** semester hours and **40** upper-division hours; **24** of the last **30** hours must be completed in residence.
